- *ignite creative responses to the GC14 Calls in the areas of personal and communal transformation, including support of the 2014 IBVM GC Corporate stance on human trafficking
- *affirm, encourage and provide support for the social ministries, justice initiatives, outreach activities and service of all members of the Loreto network
- *draw on the wisdom and experience of Loreto Sisters as resource people in justice education and formation programmes
- *encourage the integration of action and prayer/reflection in our approach to social justice
